

Achievements

1. All the data relating to 48.5 lakh pensioners of the state was digitized and Aadhaar verification has increased from 85.69% to 100% in case of NSAP. Bank account particulars have been collected from about 15 lakh beneficiaries and updated in the portal.
2. Death monitoring was taken up using new algorithm with data analytics. Expected death vacancy was indicated for every district and reporting was monitored against this benchmark. In the process, 2.67 lakh death vacancies were identified for the year 2019-20 and about 2.5 lakh for the period 2020-21. During 2021-22 monitoring was taken at block level and additional 1.51 lakh death vacancies have been identified so far. Blocks that were underreporting death vacancies were identified and steps were taken for remedy.
3. Online application for pension under NSAP and MBPY was made possible starting from 1.4.2020. About 6.36 lakh citizens applied for pension during 2021-22 and out of these applicants, pension was sanctioned in respect of 3.36 lakh. The remaining applications are being inquired into. Online processing of application till sanction was made possible.
4. Survey of children with disability: SSEPD Department has undertaken survey of CwDs for the purpose of identifying and providing basic therapeutic and rehabilitation service to all eligible cases. AWWs were taken to the nearest PHC and examined and consequent measures were suggested. 27,396 children has been detected so far. Those found eligible for treatment will either attended at local facilities or referred to SIEP for specialized care.
5. Operationalizing of SIEP Bhubaneswar: State Institute for Empowering Persons with Disability was set up during 2021-22. SIEP, Bhubaneswar has commenced its full-fledged operation from 3rd September 2021. It has all facilities and advanced equipment required for improvement & cure of children with disability. Hostels for children with disability and one of parent is started at SIEP premises. Initially children were brought from the nearby three districts viz Khordha, Cuttack and Puri. Presently 100-120 cases are attending daily. 200

CwDs are registered and 64 are discharged. Till date 5955 sessions of various therapies such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, psychotherapy, play therapy, 5535 session of pre-school long, art, craft, music etc. are provided to CwDs.

6. Operationalizing therapy centre in Sundergarh and Jajpur: Therapy Centre at Sundergarh is set up with support from DMF fund. It will be inaugurated on 3rd January 2021. All the required equipment are installed and infrastructure is ready.

Therapy Centre (CRC) at Jajpur- Process to procure required equipment started. Supply orders to vendors are issued. The centre will be operationalized from temporary location for time being. The construction of building is going on and thereafter the same will be shifted to its permanent location. It is supported by OMBADC.

7. ARC in Keonjhar and Angul: ARC, Keonjhar started its operation from 8th March 2021 but closed down due to rise in COVID cases. Again started its operation from December 2021. Both robotic therapy & fabrication/fitment of artificial limbs is operationalized successfully. It is set up with support from DMF fund.
